In 2004, Al Villegas the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor for Oxnard College needed to replace a water softener on the Oxnard campus. His positive experience with his home LifeSource System guided his recommendation for the College. In 2005, the College put their first LifeSource System in the old Occupational Education building. In 2009, Al and the school again chose LifeSource for two newly constructed buildings. A model 4140 was installed in the new Occupational Education building which houses the new cafeteria, a boiler room and the Hotel & Restaurant Management facility.
